No application will be accepted unless you attach: A copy of your public liability insurance policy issued by a company licensed and authorized to do business in the state of Wisconsin, in amounts of not less than \$100,000.00 for any one person injured or killed and a total sum of \$300,000.00 per accident, and at least \$100,000.00 for the injury to or destruction of any property of any person other than such as owned by the licensee, including without limitation because of enumeration, any property the village of Lake Delton owns or operates, or any public utility; installation, structure or other property within the village of Lake Delton; and coverage on any vehicle owned, operated or used in any of the uses covered by this chapter in the amount of \$50,000.00 per person and \$100,000.00 per accident and property damage of \$25,000.00 per accident on any such vehicle, regardless of who same are owned by.

Hauler and MRF Guidance

Your customers that are local government recycling programs (Responsible Units, or RU's) are required to report annually to the DNR the total tons of recyclable materials collected from their residents. Many RU's rely on you, their hauler or MRF, for this information.

RUs will begin working on their annual reports for 2013 in mid-February. The reports will be due to DNR on April 30, 2014.

You can help your RU customers by:

- Getting accurate recyclables (and trash, if included in your contract) tonnages to the RUs you serve so that each RU has the information they need to submit their report on time. For the best service, we suggest you send your RU customers this information before the end of January if possible.
- Using the template below for reporting tonnages of recyclables. **Adopting this format will ensure their report is accurate and avoid us having to follow up with them and you to correct the data.**
- Breaking down the tonnages by material helps the RU separate the tonnages for the basic ("Table 1") materials from the other materials.

Note that residential mixed paper grades should be included in the Table 1 Recyclable Items. Newspaper and magazines may also be included with mixed residential paper if not sorted.

Each year, DNR devotes a significant amount of staff time following up with RU's to correct tonnage data problems. The way you format your tonnage report to your RUs can affect the completeness and accuracy of tonnages they report to DNR. A report format that mirrors the DNR annual report form can reduce follow-up calls from an RU or DNR to correct dubious tonnage data

By reporting all collection in tons only, and not in pounds, you will help avoid the common error of forgetting to convert pounds or other units to tons.

Conversion factors:

Major appliances: 205 pounds each
Car or light truck tires: 21 pounds each
Lead acid batteries: 39 pounds each
One ton: 2,000 pounds
